BAPTISM: Parents who seek the Sacrament of Baptism
for their children must establish active membership in the
parish for a minimum of three months, and both parents
must have completed the Baptism Class prior to scheduling
a baptism.

FIRST COMMUNION: Students preparing to receive the
Sacrament of First Communion through our Christian
Formation Program must attend two full years of religious
formation and adhere to the attendance policy. Contact

CONFIRMATION: Students are prepared in their 8th
Grade year, through the R.O.C. program, or COK-SM
School to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Contact

RCIA: Those wishing to join in full communion with the
Catholic Church are invited to participate in the Rite of

advance prior to marriage. In the course of that time,

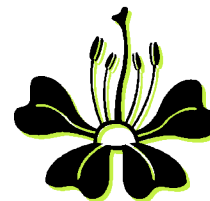
NEWS OF SENIOR TRANSPORTATION
