Sacrament of First Communion through our Christian  
Formation Program must attend two full years of religious

**CONFIRMATION:** Students are prepared in their 8th

## HAITI COLLECTION

We are all aware of the plight of our brothers and sisters in Haiti. Prior to the recent earthquake, they were a desperate people, among the poorest of the poor, where the average wage is \$1.00 per day. They are our family, those who in addition to sharing our humanity also share our Faith. Approximately 80% of Haitians are Catholic.

Last year we answered their plea for help after a devastating hurricane. Thanks to your generosity, we sent them \$40,000. Once again, we need to share our blessings and resources with them. It's an opportunity to respond to the mandate of the Gospel to "feed the hungry, give drink to the thirsty, clothe the naked and shelter the homeless."

The words of John Donne "For Whom the Bell Tolls" resonate in our ears:

*"No man is an island, entire of itself; every man is a piece of the continent, a part of the main. If a clod be washed away by the sea, Europe is the less, as well as if a promontory were, as well as if a manor of thy friend's or of thine own were: any man's death diminishes me, because I am involved in mankind, and therefore never send to know for whom the bell tolls; it tolls for thee."*

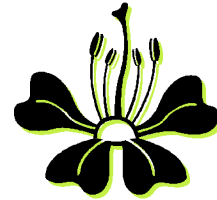

## PARISH SCHOOL NEWS:

Things remain busy at the school even as we return from the long weekend. Our thoughts, naturally, stay very much focused on the devastation and haunting pictures from Haiti (One seventh grader asked, “Aren’t they our closest, poorest neighbors, and now they’re even poorer!”) The irony hits us all. Lots of ideas have come forward for what we can do to help and try to follow guidelines from the Holy Father and our own Bishops.

One teacher offered the idea of “One Hundred for Haiti” (the students have been in school 100 days so far this year), encouraging the children to give 100 pennies – and asking parents and friends to give 100 dimes, nickels, quarters or dollars! That sounded reasonable, so we’re hoping to incorporate it into our “Giving Day” of Catholic Schools Week (1/31 through 2/5). We can also collect this via our We Give Wednesday program at the school Masses.

The eighth graders will do a bake sale and the seventh and sixth use the pre-Lenten “treats” sale to add to what we can raise. Our collections will be sent through the Catholic Relief Services who have been active in Haiti (where 86% of the population is Catholic) for many years and can, hopefully, put whatever we send to immediate good use. We are optimistic that we can do some good – and some of the older students (and most of us who were here at the time) remember that we gave the Red Cross a check for \$10,000 to help when the tsunami struck in Indonesia a few years ago. We are praying for the people and their amazingly brave rescue crews in all our classes.
