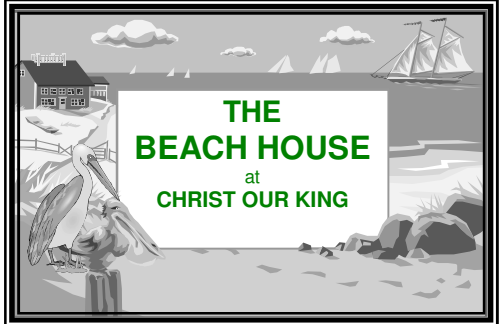

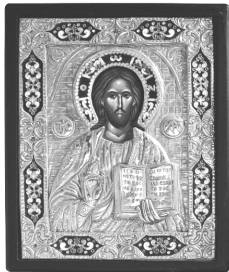


### COMBINING THE WISDOM OF OUR SENIORS & ENTHUSIASM OF OUR YOUTH

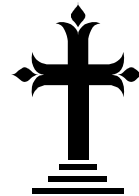

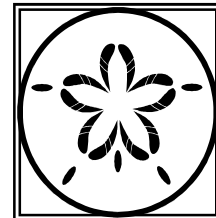
