**RESERVED SEATING:** The first pew on either side of the center aisle has been reserved for the disabled. Also, the Holy Family Chapel (votive candle room) is reserved for the disabled and the elderly.

**INFANT & CHILD CARE:** Infant and child care (ages 6 weeks to 4 years of age) is provided during the 9:30 am and 12 Noon Masses in the Preschool located in the Life Center.

**PARENTS ROOM:** For the convenience of parents not using the Nursery during Mass, a glass enclosed area (this room is not soundproof) is available in the church.

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION AND HOME

**SCHOOLING:** In accordance with Diocesan Policy and the Bishop's guidelines, parents who home school will be made aware of their responsibility to fulfill the same obligation as parents and students involved in the regular catechetical parish program. The requirements include participating in weekly meetings set up through Christian Formation and, with reference to Confirmation, also include attending the Family Honor Program, accumulating twenty hours of community service, and attending a Confirmation Retreat.

**BAPTISM:** Parents who seek the Sacrament of Baptism for their children must establish active membership in the parish for a minimum of three months, and both parents must have completed the Baptism Class prior to scheduling a baptism.

**FIRST COMMUNION:** Students preparing to receive the Sacrament of First Communion through our Christian Formation Program must attend two full years of religious formation and adhere to the attendance policy where no more than 3 classes may be missed in any one school year. Contact Sharon Willi, 971-8083, Director of Religious Education, for more information.

**CONFIRMATION:** Students are prepared in their 8th Grade year, through the R.O.C. program in which candidates must attend 2 full years of religious formation and adhere to an attendance policy (where no more than 3 classes may be missed in any one school year), or attend COK-SM School, to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. For further information, contact Mr. Austin Foster at 971-7914.

**RCIA:** Those wishing to join in full communion with the Catholic Church are invited to participate in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Please call Sister Donna Lareau, OLM, Director of Adult Faith Formation, at 971-8273, or Lola Reilly at 884-8311.

**MARRIAGE:** Arrangements must be made six months in advance prior to marriage. In the course of that time, couples must be active participants in the life of the church both in attendance and use of the envelope system. Living together before marriage is morally wrong, and couples who are living together will be asked to live separately during the marriage preparation time.

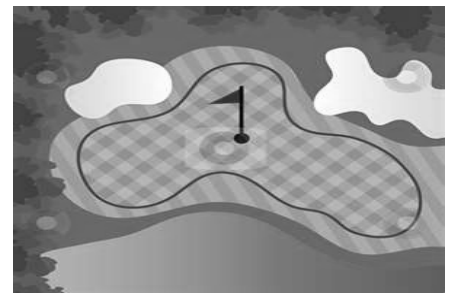

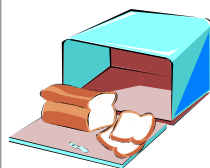

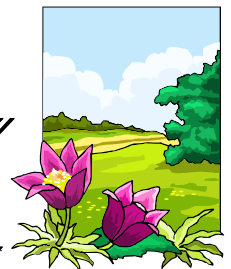

**On the Revised Translation of the Mass  
“The Mass is Heaven on Earth”**

In the Book of Revelation, Saint John has a vision of what he sees in heaven. He reports a Temple with a huge throne, in front of which stands a Lamb who seems to have been wounded. In front of this Lamb is an altar before which sits countless angels, saints, and martyrs worshipping God through the same Lamb. John says all of those worshipping sing, “holy, holy, holy is the Lord God almighty...”

Early Christians remembered that John the Baptist had called Jesus the “Lamb of God” and they thus reasoned that what Saint John saw as recorded in the Book of Revelation was nothing other than the fulfillment in heaven of what Jesus did on earth by giving His Body & Blood at the Last Supper, sacrificing Himself on the Cross on Good Friday and rising to new life on Easter Sunday. The first followers of Christ figured that what happens in heaven, as seen by Saint John, must be the model for our earthly worship of God.

Observe that when we come to Mass we approach an altar on which we make present Jesus’ Body & Blood in the bread and wine. We even sing “holy, holy, holy,” just like John sees the angels and saints doing in heaven. It follows, then, that the Mass is heaven on earth!
