Dear Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion:

I hope you have returned from summer refreshed and renewed for your ministry here at Christ Our King. Thank you for all that you do to minister to the parishioners of Christ Our King. May God bless you for your service.

Enclosed please find the Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion Schedule for September, October and November, 2011. Please review the schedule, highlight your dates, and post them where you can't miss them. It is not the responsibility of the Captain to locate a substitute for you. Remember, even if you are not scheduled to serve, please come dressed to serve.

Please note the following change in procedure for those Eucharistic Ministers who are assigned to purify the sacred vessels: After returning the vessels to the sacristy after communion, the Eucharistic Ministers should return to the body of the church. Those who have been designated to purify the vessels should remain in proximity to the sacristy door, so that at the conclusion of the closing hymn they may begin purifying the vessels without delay. By the time the priests have finished greeting the people after Mass, the Eucharistic Ministers should have completed the purification. This policy should be implemented at all Masses, effective the **first weekend in September**. If you have any questions, please make contact with your Captain.

May you perform your ministry with skill and sensitivity.
