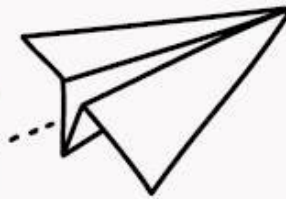


Non-Parishioner / Destination Weddings

If you are getting married in a church that is not your regular parish, here are some additional considerations:

- Your canonical paperwork needs to be completed 60-90 days prior to your wedding so that it has time to travel from your parish to your diocese to the diocese where you are being married, and then finally to the church where you will be married.



- Your pastor will need to give permission for you to marry in another church.



- Understanding the rules of the parish and diocese where you are to be married is crucial. You should not assume what is permitted in your church is allowable in another parish.
